Our Catholic Tradition

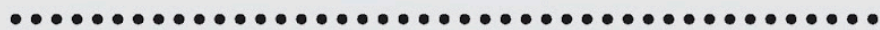
- God gave us many gifts. His gifts tell us about what he is like.
