This Family Unit is for children in Grades 1, 3, 4, & 5.

Students in Grade 2 must complete the lessons in their First Eucharist Books. Student in Grade 6 must complete the lessons in their Confirmation Books. They <u>do not</u> need to complete Unit 6.

Alive in Christ is a "spiral" curriculum where certain core concepts or lessons are revisited and built upon over multiple grade levels. This means that children will encounter these core lessons in each grade, but with increasing complexity and depth as they progress.
